1. Preparation & Use of Class Time (10 pts)

- **Excellent (10–9):** Always used class time well and came prepared.
- **Good (8–7):** Sometimes wasted time or forgot something.
- **Needs Work (6–0):** Often off-task or not prepared.

2. Content & Organization (10 pts)

- **Excellent (10–9):** Story has a clear beginning, middle, and end. The problem and solution are easy to follow and interesting.
- **Good (8–7):** Story mostly makes sense, but may be a little confusing or missing one part.
- **Needs Work (6–0):** Story is hard to follow, very short, or missing important parts.

3. Language Use (8 pts)

- **Excellent (8–7):** Uses good vocabulary, grammar is correct, and ideas are clear.
- **Good (6–5):** Some mistakes, but we can still understand.
- **Needs Work (4–0):** Many mistakes make it hard to understand.

4. Storybook Visuals (8 pts)

- **Excellent (8–7):** Drawings are neat and match the story well.
- **Good (6–5):** Pictures are okay but don't add much detail or effort.
- **Needs Work (4–0):** Pictures are messy, missing, or don't match the story.

5. Presentation & Engagement (8 pts)

- **Excellent (8–7):** Reads clearly and loudly enough. Looks at the audience, uses expression, and makes the story fun to listen to.
- **Good (6–5):** Understandable, but sometimes too quiet, flat, or looks at the book too much.
- **Needs Work (4–0):** Hard to hear, no expression, or only reads without engaging the audience.

6. Listening & Respect (6 pts)

- **Excellent (8–7):** Listens quietly, respects classmates, and asks at least one good question.
- **Good (6–5):** Listens most of the time, but maybe distracted. Question is simple.
- **Needs Work (4–0):** Doesn't listen, interrupts, or no question.
